

RONNIE FLOYD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Scholarship Description

This award has been made possible by the establishment of an ongoing scholarship fund by the Floyd family to honor the memory Revered Ronnie Floyd. The intent of the scholarship is to encourage qualified candidates to pursue their call to full-time ministry through faithfully excelling in areas of academics and practical ministry.

The RFMS Board awards one \$8,000 per academic year to a qualified applicant. Funds will be distributed \$4,000 per semester. Second semester funds will only be distributed if the applicant maintains good standing with a minimum 3.0 GPA in all classes. Failure to maintain these standards will result in forfeiture of remaining scholarship funds.

Applicant Requirements

- Full-time enrolled in Lifepoint College with good standing
 - If enrolled full-time in Lifepoint College Plus, must also be in good standing with Southeastern University
- Maintaining a GPA of a minimum of 3.0 in all classes
- Must have a trajectory and desire to pursue a career in full-time ministry
- First-time applicants will receive priority

Application Process

- 1. Qualified applicants must personally complete the application and onepage essay. They must also request a letter of recommendation from a pastor or other church staff member to submit with their application.
- 2. Applications will be submitted to the Lifepoint College offices by the deadline for consideration.
- 3. Applications will be reviewed by the RFMS Board due the deadline to select the top 2 or 3 candidates to move forward to the panel interview process.
- 4. Top applicants are notified and scheduled for a panel interview by the deadline.
- 5. Panel interviews are conducted by the RFMB and a winning applicant will be selected by deadline.
- 6. Winning applicant will be notified in writing.
 - a. Letter of Congratulations
 - b. Scholarship Certificate
- 7. RFMB will notify Finance Office as to the distribution of funds.
